President-Chair's report

This 115th Annual Report of the Wellington Rowing Association (the Association) sets out the highlights of the 2016/17 year.

Regattas

The tabulated results reflect the reality of the local season with several regattas once again having to be cancelled due to windy weather. Safety will always be paramount in regatta go-no-go decisions.

The Board has empathy with the competitors who miss out on valuable racing experience compounded by frequent indifferent training conditions. Regatta locations and alternatives are often discussed by the Board, but options are limited and shelter from the wind a challenge.

The Star Sesquicentennial Redding Shield opening day regatta was enjoyed by all with racing being held on Lambton Harbour in the presence of many past Star BC rowers attending the 150th celebrations. Porirua Rowing Club also celebrated 50 years with a weekend of rowing and catching up with old friends. Congratulations to both clubs on these milestones!

Another highlight for the local season was the secondary schools' McLachlan Shield regatta. Good entries ensured competitive racing for all participants.

One notes with pleasure the enjoyable experience for all at our regattas with officials being supported by enthusiastic volunteers and competitors receiving encouraging advice from dedicated coaches. Positive parental support is evident.

Regatta officials will continue to ensure regattas are run efficiently and safely on testing water conditions allowing competitors to measure their progress and prepare for regattas on the national championship courses.

Licensed competitors

The Association has 473 competitors licensed through Rowing New Zealand; spread across the five clubs (note: clubs also have additional non-licensed competitors). This is positive growth on previous years.

Coach development and coach boat safety

The Association continues to provide the example for how a local association should support coaches in its region.

This year, the Association funded a number of local coach development initiatives including:

- Four Club Safety Boat Operator courses.
- Nine local coaches to attend the Rowing NZ Coaches Conference at Lake Karapiro in May of this year.
- Nine coaches funded to attend Central RPC Development Camps run by Mark James in Blenheim. Coaches who attended commented positively on these camps, emphasising the excellent learning environment that the Central RPC provides for rowers and coaches alike.
- Twenty first-year coaches attended a two-day session run by Mark James at the Petone Rowing Club over the winter.
- Three informal coach 'catch up' sessions were run, with speakers Marion Horwell, Mark James, and Axel Dickinson.

The Board takes the view that contributing to coach development is an excellent way to give back to the region. It provides our coaches with further knowledge and experience with which they can improve the quality of their coaching and safety of our rowers in the region.

Wellington Schools' Committee

One of the outcomes of the update of the Association's Rules in 2016 was the establishment of the Wellington Schools' Committee (the Committee).

- **Wellington Rowing Association Schools' Director:** Sean Durkin
- **Current members of the Committee:** Scots College, St Mary's College, Paraparaumu College, Hutt Valley High School, Onslow College, Queen Margaret College, St Patrick's College (Town), Wellington Girls College, and Wellington College.

The Committee provides an avenue for schools to get involved in the governance of rowing in the region, and further provides an ability to voice concerns to the Board.

The Committee also acts as the Wellington Secondary Schools Rowing Association and has representation through the New Zealand Secondary Schools Rowing Association (NZSSRA). At the 2017 NZSSRA Annual General Meeting, the Committee put forward a number of remits, many of which passed. For further information on these remits, please visit the NZSSRA website.

The Committee has had a successful first year. Specific initiatives planned for the coming season include:

- reviewing the programme of events for the McLachlan Shield;

- engaging more schools in the Wellington region to participate at the NZSSRA AGM every year; and
 - investigating a Wellington Indoor Rowing Secondary School Championships.

Koro Koro Shed

Thanks to Laurie Counsell and Warrick Fowlie for the significant amount of maintenance work, ensuring the building is fit for purpose. Thanks also to our shed manager, Ross Tait.

The shed has now been repainted and thanks are extended to The Infinity Foundation and Four Winds Foundation for grants to cover \$12,000 of the approximately \$17,000 cost.

Other work carried out in the shed during the last year was:

- additional boat racks built in the seaward side. These were designed to hold two un-rigged boats each. and lifted the total boat storage capability of the shed to 41 boats.
- rigger storage racks built at the end of the seaward side and in the toilet block annex.
- additional oar racks built.
- mitigation measures taken to minimise excess rainwater flowing into the main shed through the roller doors during times of heavy rain.
- mitigation measures taken to prevent flooding of the changing rooms during times of heavy rain.
- hand basin installed in the toilet block.
- changing rooms renovated and painted.
- Extra lighting installed inside the rail side.

Finance

The Association achieved around break even on its operations over the year. Revenue of \$43,000 included \$14,000 in grants. The Pelorus Trust grant of \$2,000 enabled further safety boat courses to be held.

There was a net cost of \$5,000 on the shed painting project after grants. Thanks to Steve Manners for his work on obtaining grants.

The Association's net assets of \$92,000 are cash assets.

The Board will continue to budget for a financial surplus enabling the net assets to increase providing for a reserve for any capital project and consideration of supporting Central Rowing Performance Centre requirements.

New Zealand Rowing Association 130th Annual General Meeting

Wellington Rowing Association (the Association) was represented by Andrew Carr-Smith and Sean Durkin at the New Zealand Rowing Association (NZRA) meeting on 21 May 2017 in Rotorua.

The Association presented a series of successful remits and amendments. The Association's proposal to rationalise the number of NZRA Officers was accepted. One Vice-President role has already been dis-established. The other Vice-President and Vice-Patron roles will also cease to exist over the coming years.

Significantly, the Association's proposal to revitalise classification according to ability was also accepted (after some amendment from Southern Associations). The 2017-18 Season will now see the introduction of a new Intermediate class and an expanded Senior class.

Amendments from the Association in relation to classification according to gender and age were also unanimously adopted. In addition to these successes the Association continued a tradition of ensuring the AGM proceeded smoothly by nominating, moving, and seconding items of business.

Life Membership

Life Membership of the Wellington Rowing Association was awarded to Anthony Harold Debbage at the 114th Annual General Meeting. The citation follows.

The name of Anthony Debbage, universally known as Tony, first appeared on Wellington's regatta programme in the 1973/74 season as stroke of the Porirua Rowing Club's Youths 8+, Youths and Lightweight 4+. He continued to row for his club until at least 1982 when his name appears in the entries for the Premier 2x and 1x. He was thus one of the Club's earlier competitive members, the Club only founded in 1967.



After retirement from racing Tony is known to have continued his involvement with rowing at Porirua, but unfortunately the Association's records from 1985-1993 are missing and it has therefore not been possible to ascertain details for this period. However, we do know that Tony held office as President of the Porirua Rowing Club before being made a life member of the Club in 1994.

Tony's participation in the affairs of the Association began sometime before 1990, the year in which he became a New Zealand Licenced Regatta Umpire. He was elected a Vice-President and then President of the Association in 1994, an office he continued to hold until 2002 at a time of considerable uncertainty over the future path of rowing in this country.



Tony's retirement from office and responsibility was short-lived. He accepted office as a Director in the newly constituted Board of the Association from 2004-2006, and then, after a short break, became an Elected Director in 2009 - 2014. He was the Safety Officer, conducting courses, and patrolling our local regattas.

Tony was awarded a New Zealand Rowing Association Service Award in 2000, and now, in recognition of his enduring contribution to rowing in many capacities over a period exceeding 40 years, the Wellington Rowing Association honours him with its Life Membership.

Petone to Ngauranga cycle way / Petone-Grenada Link

The Hutt City Council has approved the widening of the cycle way. The Board is seeking clarification with NZTA on any implications there may be for access to the Koro Koro shed.

Similarly, Board representatives will meet with NZTA to discuss plans for the Petone-Grenada link.
