President-Chair's report

This 116th Annual Report of the Wellington Rowing Association (the Association) sets out the highlights of the 2017/18 year.

Regatta review

Summarised regatta results for the 2017/18 season show one of the three scheduled long distance races being completed and four of the six scheduled regattas (one of the four was shortened).

While acknowledging wind direction and velocity are the obvious uncontrollable variables, the continuing trend of disruptive regatta programmes prompted the Board to undertake an extensive regatta review with agreed Terms of Reference for the sub-committee to follow.

A draft report was presented and adopted for implementation at the June 2018 Board meeting. A report summary is included as an attachment to this Annual Report.

My thanks to Deidre Burke, Laurie Counsell and Warrick Fowlie for jointly convening the regatta review sub-committee and for the constructive input from the clubs.

The staging of regattas is our core business and athletes and coaches should welcome the changes being implemented for next season.

Governance

I can report a successful year for the Board with generally well attended bi-monthly meetings and a high level of competency displayed by portfolio holders covering regatta officiating, secretarial, financial, grant applications, coaching development, together with general governance and stewardship.

Coach development and coach boat safety

After the successful Coaches' Conference at Lake Karapiro in May 2017, the Association provided a regional mini-conference in August followed by the rollout of the new level 1 and Level 2 coaching courses (funded by WRA) and attended by 22 coaches and 120 athletes and parents.

Five coaches attended the September Level 1 Coaches course.

Three safety boat courses were also held during the year.

Further coach development courses will be available this winter with Mark James and Jared Cummings (RNZ Coach Developers).

Koro Koro shed

Repainting of the exterior of the shed was completed during the year together with the installation of new spouting.

Internally, the toilet block was relined and panted and separate men's and women's changing rooms created. A dispensing system for dispensing an environment-friendly detergent for washing boats was also installed; ensuring runoff into the sea will cause no harm.

Finance

The Association achieved a \$4,581 surplus for the year. Revenue of \$58,000 included \$21,831 in grants.

The Association acknowledges with gratitude grants from Pelorus Trust, Infinity Foundation and Four Winds Foundation, for cost of shed painting, safety boat operator courses for coaches, umpires and umpire boat drivers, and to purchase more buoys to allow for better, safer marking of the course around the finish line/boat launching area.

The Association's net assets of \$84,200 are cash assets.

The Board will continue to budget for a financial surplus enabling the net assets to increase providing for a reserve for any capital project and for consideration of support for the likes of the Central Rowing Performance Centre.

A fixed asset register is annexed to the report.

New Zealand Rowing Association's 131th AGM

The Association was represented by Sean Durkin and Andrew Carr-Smith at the New Zealand Rowing Association Annual General Meeting (AGM) on 19 May 2018 in Dunedin.

This AGM remembered Colin Shields, Wellington Rowing Association Life Member and New Zealand Rowing Association Past President, among those of the rowing community who had passed away during the year.

Also during the AGM Nina Brown (President of Wellington Rowing Club) was recognised as Wellington Rowing Association's Volunteer of the Year. Sean Durkin became the New Zealand Secondary School Rowing Association's (NZSSRA) inaugural Volunteer of the Year; in recognition for his work with the Wellington Secondary School Rowing Association (WSSRA).

Following on from 2017, and as planned, the new classifications according to ability were adjusted. They are still different to what the Association originally proposed. But the adjustments are positive. Adjustment will continue to be an ongoing process.

In a new development, with unanimous support from the other Local Associations, WRA put forward a motion that should see Intermediate events raced during the 2019 Nationals.

The NZRA AGM will return to Wellington in 2019. NZSSRA (NZRA's newest Local Association) will be the official hosts.
